MEETING ROOMS & FUNCTION SPACE

Providing the entire group is staying at Grand Hotel, there is no charge for most contracted meeting rooms or for the use of public areas of the hotel for group functions; some private rooms may have a nominal rental charge. Groups not staying at Grand Hotel must pay a rental fee to host functions at the hotel. All food and beverages for functions must be purchased from Grand Hotel. Your convention manager can assist in making all arrangements.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

Grand Hotel provides one eight-foot table, a red tablecloth, one electrical outlet, two chairs, and one wastebasket, included in our exhibit charge. Our staff will assist in moving exhibits once at the hotel. Exhibitors are responsible for making boat and drayage service arrangements and for paying all transportation charges to and from the hotel. Your event manager can help you locate a professional exhibit company, if needed.

AUDIOVISUAL EQUIPMENT

Grand Hotel maintains a large, in-house inventory of audiovisual equipment which is available to our guests free of charge with contracted meeting space. If your group requires special equipment or equipment operators we do not have, Grand Hotel will be happy to rent the equipment or hire an AV technician and pass the charges on to the group. Please discuss your needs with an event manager well in advance to allow for special arrangements.

BANNERS

All banners must have grommets and ropes for hanging purposes. Outside-located banners must also have wind slots and be made of a weather-resistant material. All banners must be communicated with your event manager prior to arrival. The hotel charges \$50 per banner to be hung on the property; this includes both set-up and take down charges.

Our 2023 scone for Afternoon Tea Service is a candied orange scone. The star of this offering is our Housemade Cherry Jam. Each summer, cherries are harvested by local Michigan farmers and sent to Grand Hotel. Our pastry team then prepares and jars the jams in house.

We dove into our menu archives, found a dessert menu from 1890 that includes brandy jelly, and married the old and new in Brandy Jelly Bonbons. The brandy jelly is layered with Michigan maple crème, covered in dark chocolate, and sprinkled with Maldon salt.

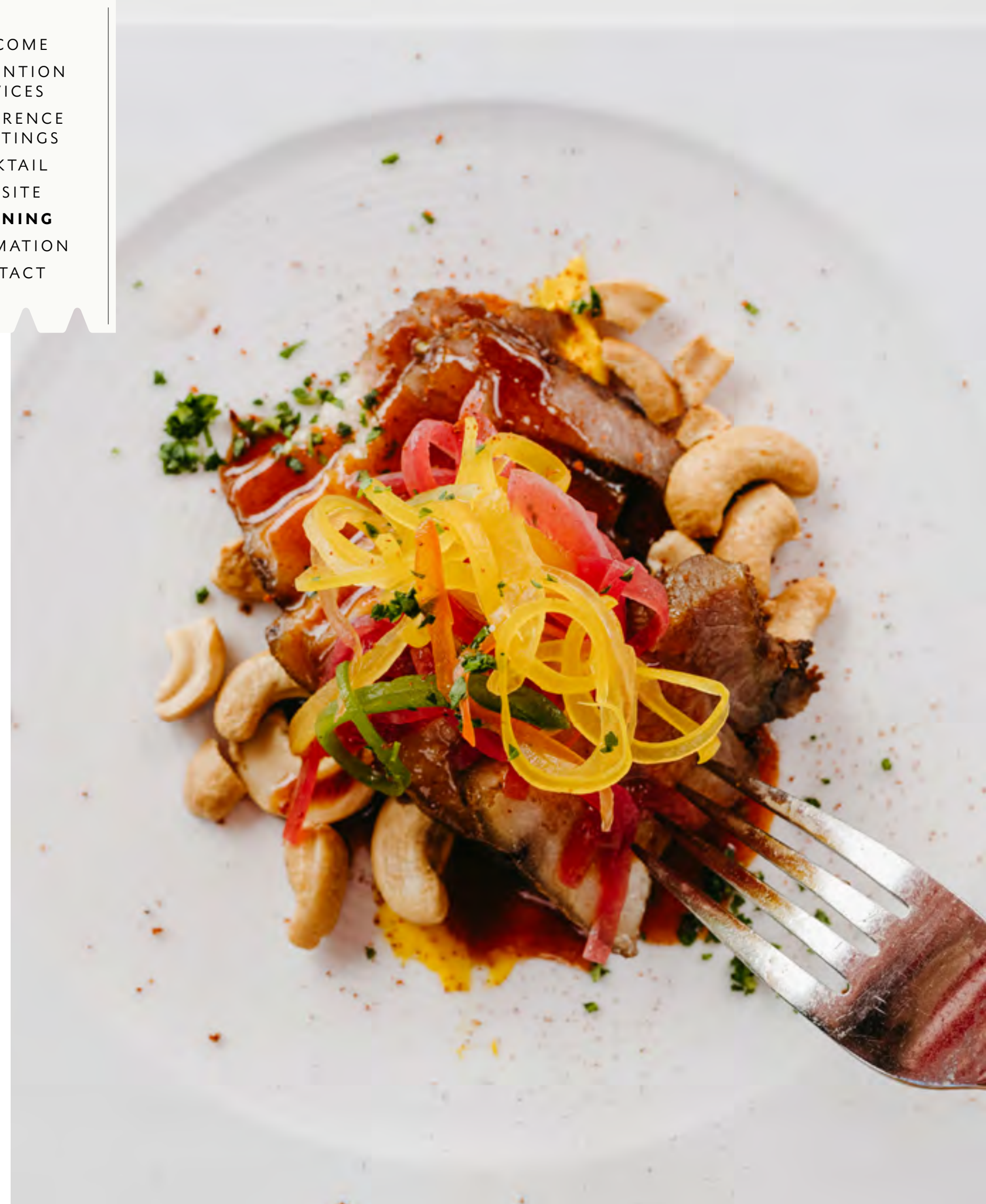

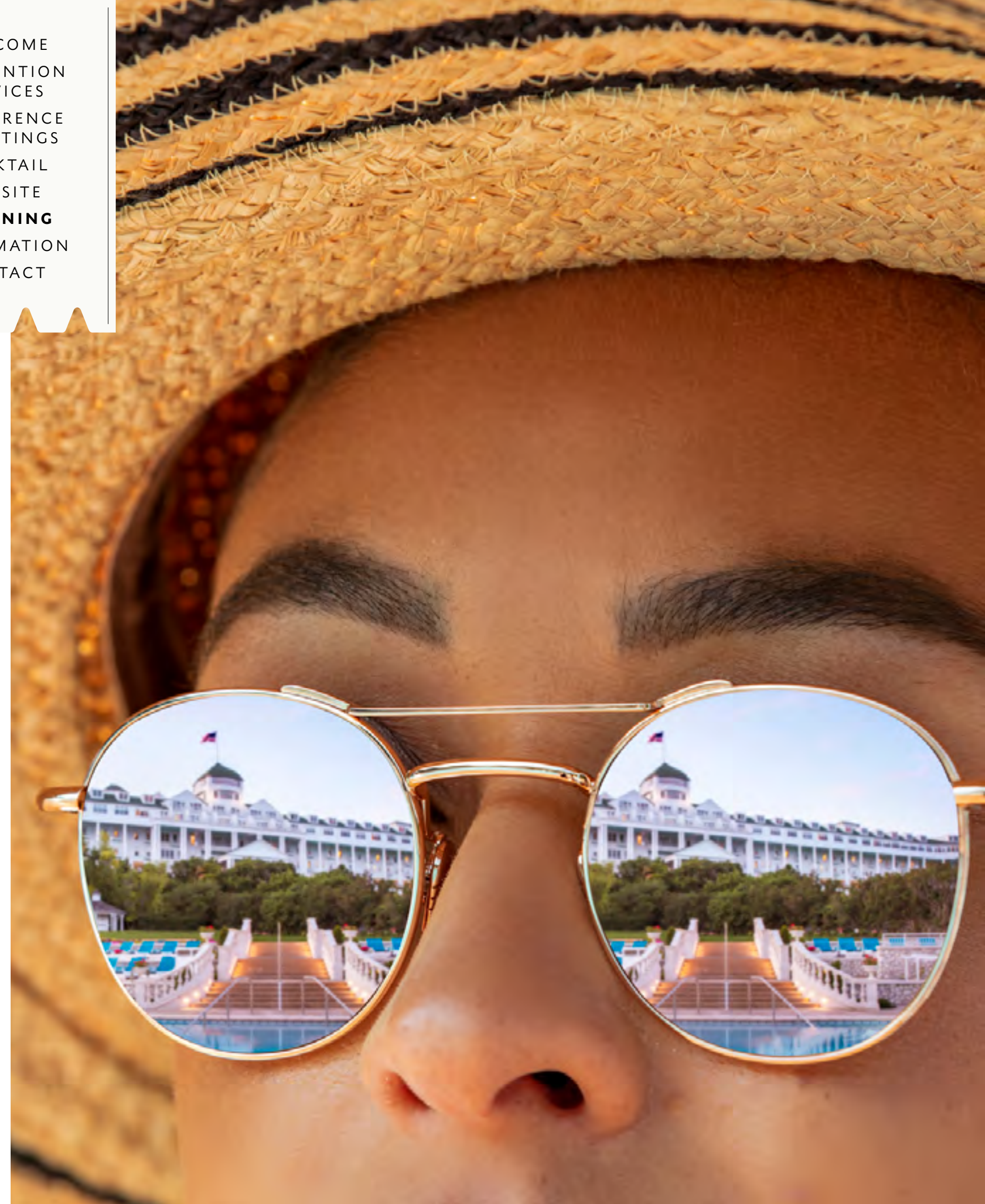

GENERAL

In keeping with our policy of impeccable service, we will assign you an event manager—a specially trained staff member versed in all aspects of meeting planning, who will handle every detail of your meeting from beginning to end.

TIPPING

Tipping is now available for all bars inside of Grand Hotel as well as for servers in the Main Dining Room, if guests would like to leave a gratuity. Tipping is suggested at the following off-site restaurant locations: The Jockey Club, Woods Restaurant, The Gate House, Esther's Pool Grill, Mackinac Island Pizza Company, and Fort Mackinac Tea Room.

MEAL FUNCTIONS

Your event manager and Grand Hotel's Executive Chef will work with you to design a menu for your function. Any suggestions submitted from our Executive Chef will be submitted to you. Please approve them no later than 30 days prior to the function.

GUARANTEE

We require a guarantee of the number of persons attending all food and beverage functions at least 14 days prior to the event. If no guarantee is received, Grand Hotel will use the number of guests contracted as your guarantee. You will be charged for the actual number served or the guarantee, whichever is greater. All organized golf tournaments and outings are required to have the tee times and number of golfers guaranteed on the group's arrival night.

MEAL PRICES

There may be added charges for private meal functions when they are served within Grand Hotel, in lieu of the regular Modified American Plan (MAP) breakfast and/or dinner in the Main Dining Room. There may be some surcharges that will apply; see your event manager for more information.

There will be a surcharge for special upgraded menus, buffets, and all off-site functions.

All menu prices are subject to change.

Dinner at The Jockey Club and The Gate House can be reserved in lieu of the MAP normally provided in the Main Dining Room; beverages and server gratuities are not included.

For all group functions in our outlets, a 23% automatic gratuity will apply.

BILLING

Billing arrangements for all events must be made at least 60 days prior to the function. Any group that requests tax exemption must contact their event manager at least 30 days prior to their first arrival date. All master accounts must be settled prior to arrival unless direct billing has been approved. See your sales manager and event manager for direct billing applications. If direct billing is not approved, any outstanding charge must be settled on departure day. All master accounts and deposits paid by credit card are subject to a 2.5% processing charge.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

Grand Hotel is the only authorized licensee to sell, serve, or furnish liquor, beer, wine, or food on these premises. No food or beverage of any kind is permitted to be brought into any public area of the hotel. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. All prices are subject to change. A 23% service fee and 6% Michigan sales tax will automatically be applied to all food and beverage charges incurred at Grand Hotel.

GUEST ATTIRE

Since Grand Hotel is a resort, we want you to feel at ease and dress comfortably. During the day, casual resort clothing is appropriate. Prior to 6:30 p.m., please no midriff baring tops, sweatpants, or cut-off shorts for the ladies. For gentlemen, no sleeveless shirts, sweatpants, or cut-off shorts. Since every evening at Grand Hotel is a special occasion, after 6:30 p.m. dresses, skirts, blouses, dress sweaters, and dress slacks for ladies are preferred, while gentlemen are required to wear a suit coat, necktie, and dress pants; no denim or shorts. This applies to all areas inside the hotel with the exception of the Cupola Bar. Children 12 years and older are expected to be in dress similar to that of the adults.

HOTEL LIABILITY

Grand Hotel is not responsible for any equipment or materials left unattended in any area of the resort. Damages to the premises will be charged accordingly. Prior arrangements must be made with your event manager for the security of exhibits, merchandise or articles set up for display.
